A note from W. S. Hyde announces the death of his mother at his home on Tuesday morning at 1:30, at the age of 57 years. Mrs. Hyde was taken sick Wednesday of last week with acute indigestion, but was not more than ordinarily sick until Saturday, then the doctor said she was threatened with typhoid fever.
