

Rev. I. Lundeby, of Bue, died in St. Paul last Thursday from the effects of an operation performed on him a few days previous. Mr. Lundeby had been a sufferer from kidney and liver trouble. His remains were brought back home and the funeral took place last Sunday afternoon, the remains being followed to their last resting place by the largest procession of teams ever seen in this country.
