

Mrs. Guro Odegard, wife of T. J. Odegard, died last Sunday night at 10:30 after a long and painful sickness. The deceased had been a great sufferer for a long time and had been in bed for over three months, during which time she had the best of medical attendance and the constant care of her friends.
