

Grandma Wylie Dead.

Mrs. Hulda L. Wylie, whom everybody knew as "Grandma" Wylie, died this morning of pneumonia in her rooms in the McDonald building on Broadway, aged about 74 years. Grandma Wylie had been sick about four weeks with pneumonia, and this and a complication of heart trouble was the cause of her death. Her grand-daughter Mrs. Fleming, tenderly nursed her through her last illness.

Mrs. Wylie is one of the old settlers of Valley City, having come here with her husband in 1879 and joined her sons and daughters already here. Her husband died in 1889, since which time she has made her home with her children.

Mrs. Wylie was the mother of seven children, six of whom are still living—Edger W. and Scott W., now in British Columbia, Chester L., of Fargo, Willis R. and Melitas E., of Valley City, and Mrs. Flick of Griggs county and a large number of grandchildren.

The funeral will be held Saturday from Epworth M. E. church.—Times Record.
