

Mr. Hans Lunde, brother of R. S. Lunde died at midnight last Friday from consumption. Deceased was taken sick with the grippe last fall from which he could not recover. Consumption set in and he gradually grew worse until he died. He had been at Valley City for the past two months under Dr. Platou's care, but the dread disease had too great a hold and medical treatment was of no avail. Deceased returned from Valley City on the train last Friday in an exhausted condition and immediately went to bed, at the home of his brother R. S. Lunde. About 10:30 that evening he seemed to feel better and eat some soft eggs and other nourishing food, he then went to sleep and never awoke. He was 27 years old and an exemplary young man in every way.
