

LIGHTNING KILLS MAN

Man and Three Horses Instantly Killed while at Work in Field

Courtenay, N. D., June 2.—A man and three horses were instantly killed when working on the farm of Cashier Paul Sjerseeth of the First National Bank, 7 miles northwest of Courtenay.

Manly Cutsforth, the unfortunate man, was harrowing with a four-horse team when the bolt descended, instantly killing him and three of the four horses. The horse that escaped was one of the inside animals.

Cutsforth was about 20 years of age, and unmarried and came from Cheteck, Wis.

Coroner Guest at Jameseown was notified but deemed an inquest unnecessary and the body was prepared here for burial.
