

RUN OVER AND KILLED

John Haugen, a brother of Johnny Haugen of this village, was killed almost instantly last Tuesday evening near Dazey when he was run over by his team and wagon.

Mr. Haugen had recently rented a farm south of Dazey. That evening, accompanied by his little son, he had been north of Dazey for a load of hay, and was walking in the road in front of his team to keep warm while the boy was on the load driving. An auto came up behind them, frightening the horses, and Mr. Haugen tried to quiet them, standing at their heads and holding onto the bridles. In plunging about the horses somehow got Mr. Haugen under their feet and they and the wagon passed over him, his skull being crushed and several other bones being broken. The accident happened only about a half mile from Dazey, but by the time the doctor was summoned, and had brought the injured man to town, the injuries proved of so serious a nature that he died, without regaining consciousness, a few minutes after reaching town.

This is an exceptionally sad accident for the reason that deceased leaves a wife and seven small children to mourn the loss of a husband and father. In this hour of great bereavement the sympathy of the entire community is extended to them.
