

Hazel Johnson, who died Saturday evening, March 28, 1914, was born March 8, 1899, on present farm of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Halvor C. Johnson near Dazey. She had epileptic attacks when a child, and suffered from them at intervals all her life. About March 26 the attacks started to get worse and she was confined to her bed the last two days. A short time before she died she was relieved of the attacks. The funeral services were held at the house on Tuesday, Rev. P. A. Thoreson speaking in English to a number of friends and neighbors. Services were held in the church at Hannaford at 2:30 Rev. Thoreson conducting the services in Norwegian. Interment was made in Lutheran cemetery north of town.
