David Kalland died at St. Luke's hospital at Fargo on Friday, Aug. 7, after a brief illness of only a few days with throat and lung trouble. He was taken to Karnak Monday, and Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the house and from Union church the funeral services were held and interrment made in Union cemetery.
