

Obituary.

Tracy Merriman died at 8:20 Wednesday evening at the home of his son-in-law, Wm. Harris, on the old Langdon farm, appoplexy being the cause of his death.

Fifteen minutes before his death he was up and doing chores around the place; that day he had been saying that he felt better than he had for a long time, but when the stroke came he lived only for a very few minutes.

Deceased was in his sixty-sixth year, was born in Liberty City, Ind., and had lived there all his life with the exception of one year spent in Kansas. Just a month ago he came to Griggs county to spend the fall months with his son-in-law.

Deceased is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Wm. Harris, and three grandchildren. Four brothers and one sister are also living. His wife died twenty-six years ago leaving a daughter at that time only eighteen months old.

The remains were shipped from here to Liberty City last Friday, and the funeral was held Monday, Sept. 9th, at 10 o'clock.
