

The Grassy Lake Gazette gives the following account of the recent death of H. H. Sonju: Hans Sonju is dead. While peacefully sleeping he passed away on Thursday morning, Aug. 6. He had been feeling sick for about two weeks but no worse than usual when he went to bed on Wednesday night and when Mrs. Sonju went into his room in the morning she was terribly shocked to find him dead. He had intended moving out to the homestead on Wednesday but postponed it for a day thinking he would be better. Coroner McNicol, of Lethbridge, held an inquest that was merely a formality as there was no doubt that death was from natural causes. Deceased had heart trouble which was complicated by pneumonia lasting for several days. Mr. Sonju came to Grassy Lake from Hannaford, N. D., in 1909 and took up a homestead six miles south of town. He was 58 years of age and leaves a widow and little son in Grassy Lake and three grown-up sons in the state of Wisconsin.
