

Myrtle, the 8-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Taxdahl, died of infantile paralysis on Monday, April 1 at 4:30 p. m. She was taken sick Thursday, March 28 and soon became paralyzed and intermittently unconscious. In spite of all that the doctors and nurse could do she gradually grew worse, became totally unconscious, and remained so until death. The remains were interred in the Westley cemetery. The place is under strict quarantine and all precautions are taken to prevent a spread of this dread disease. A younger girl in the family also has a mild form of the disease but seems to be recovering nicely. None of the other children have so far shown any symptoms.—Cooperstown Courier.
