

Evald Mathiassen, of San Francisco, left yesterday for his home after having attended the funeral of his brother, **Sverre Uggelvik**, who was buried Saturday in Union cemetery, Rev. P. A. Thoreson officiating. **Sverre** died Friday, April 3, at a Fargo hospital, of spinal meningitis, resulting from injuries received from lifting a hay rack. He was ill only about two weeks from the time he received his injury, but was delirious the last three or four days. He was only 22 years old, had worked for **Julius Haugen** two years and before that had been employed in **Hanford** three years. **Sverre** was an accommodating and industrious boy and had numerous friends who will mourn his untimely demise.
