Alfred Brunsvold, who is now at Moline, Ill., and is employed at the Moline Plow factory, familiarizing himself with the plow business in order to become salesman or expert for the company, writes that he found the factory a bigger institution than he had expected; and there are many different departments with each one of which it would probably take a person months to get acquainted. On February 4th it was only 3 degrees below zero at Moline but owing to a peculiarity of the climate it feels colder there than it does in North Dakota when the thermometer registers 39 degrees below zero, due it is claimed to the damp breeze from the Mississippi valley.
