

Mr. and Mrs. E. C. Evenson, Mr. Evenson's mother, and Mandy Evenson, made an auto trip to Lake Preston, South Dakota, last week. The trip took only six days including a three day's stay at Lake Preston, where Mr. Evenson has a sister. The total number of miles traveled was approximately 700 miles. In that part of South Dakota harvest is already underway and they are having a splendid crop there this year. The raising of stock and dairying seems to be the chief industries. For about twelve miles they followed the Minneapolis - Yellowstone Park highway and along its smooth surface enjoyed an exhilarating race with an Overland.
