We learn that our old friend, I. W. - Barnum, one of the grand old men of Sanborn in pioneer days, has sued his nephew to whom he deeded his property here and elsewhere, under agreement that the plaintiff and wife should be maintained and cared for during their natural life, for an accounting of the estate. Mr. Barnum charges that the property has been disposed of and he has been turned out to make his own living, which is pretty hard for a man 78 years old and crippled at that. We knew Mr. Barnum as a liberal, public-spirited, christian gentleman, and believe he is deserving of a better fate.
