Ed Sites accidentally discharged a 22 calibre bullet from a rifle downward through the calf of his left leg last Friday morning, and Dr. Lang extracted it from the front along side of the shin bone. The bullet traversed a distance of about six inches in its course through the leg and will make Mr. Sites limp some before the wound is entirely healed. He was riding a sulky plow and carrying the gun for the purpose of killing gophers when the accident occurred. Many accidents have happened in this way in North Dakota and the list will be increased from year to year, despite the frequent warnings. Carrying fire arms while plowing or seeding is a dangerous practice.
