
Fire Arms Accident.

Elmer Smith of Clark City accidentally shot himself with a 22 calibre rifle while riding in a buggy last Monday. The ball first took effect in the fleshy part of the thigh, scoring the skin deep enough to bring blood, and then passed into the upper part of the arm near the elbow and penetrated into the biceps, where it remained lodged. He was accompanied to Valley City by Dr. Lang, after probing had failed to reveal the location of the bullet, to get the benefit of the X-ray test. Its location was established, but it was decided not to extract unless it should threaten future trouble. The wound is considered slight and does not seem to inconvenience Mr. Smith in the least.
