

Death of Lionel Langer.

Lionel Le Roy Langer, aged 15 years, died at the home of his mother in this place last Monday afternoon, Dec. 15th, after a brief illness.

Lional complained of feeling unwell on Saturday and on the advise of his brother went home and to bed. He broke out with measles but was not considered dangerously sick. Monday other complications set in and he died that afternoon between two and three o'clock.
