Minot, N. D., April 11.—James Luny, a farmer living nineteen miles from Portal, Ward county, was found dead beside a box car at Portal.

Luny, who had been drinking with a crowd of companions in the car, got into a fight with them and was murdered. The blood was still running from his ears, and there was a frightful wound on his face.

The fatal wound must have been given to him in the car, for there was evidence of his having crawled from the car to the ground and under the car. He was lying on the opposite side of the car when found dead. The companions had skipped.
