

Col. Tyner Dead.

The many friends of Col. Noah N. Tyner will regret to learn of his death which occurred at Augusta, Ill., Nov. 21, after an illness of two years, during which he suffered from a complication of diseases.

After the close of the war he was engaged in newspaper work, chiefly as correspondent for New York and Chicago papers until 1880, when he went to Fargo, N. D. While there he was postmaster for four years, and at one time editor of The Dakota Daily edition of The St. Paul Pioneer Press. While in Dakota he was made adjutant general of that state, occupying that office for two years, during which time he received his commission as brigadier general of militia. Subsequently, he received an offer which he accepted and held for four years, on the editorial staff of The Daily Oregonian, Portland.
