Two Well-Known People, Former Residents of This Section Pass To the Great Beyond.

DEATH OF MRS. F. J. BLAIR.

February 6th, 1904, at Rocky Ford, Colo., Mrs. Mary A. Blair, the beloved wife of F. J. Blair, died of heart failure, aged 38 years, 10 months and 25 days.

Last fall Mr. Blair sold his farm and other property here and removed to Colorado in the vain hope that a change of climate might prove beneficial to his wife's health which had been failing for some time.
