## JUDGE COCHRANE DEAD.

John M. Cochrane, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, Died at His Home at Grand Forks Yesterday.

Grand Forks, July 20.—John M. Cochrane, associate justice of the state supreme court, dropped dead here this morning.

For many years Justice Cochrane has been in poor physical condition as a result of heart trouble. For the last few months his condition had grown more serious and attacks were more frequent. Last night he suffered considerably from the heat and was not feeling well. This morning at 10 o'clock he dropped dead.

Mr. Cochrane was born in Franklin county, Pennsylvania, March 8, 1859, and was the son of James and Caroline A. (McDowell) Cochrane.
