

DEATH OF MILES KISER, JR.

Miles Kiser, the 14 year old son of Mr. and Mrs. Miles D. Kiser, of Rogers, died at St. John's Hospital in Fargo last Saturday, January 24, 1905, after an operation for appendicitis. The lad was taken to the hospital about seven weeks ago, but it was feared at the time that it was too late for a successful operation.

Mr. Kiser and two of his sons left Fargo the day before the boy died, not expecting fatal results would so soon follow.

The body was brought to Sanborn and was buried from the Congregational church, Rev. Jos. N. Haskell conducting the services. The church was crowded with friends of the stricken family, testifying to their sorrow at the sore bereavement. Interment in Sanborn cemetery.

The deceased was born here in the house now occupied by Miles Standish, his parents being old residents of this place. The family has our sincere sympathy.
