

Obituary.

Mr. Julius W. Langer died Jan. 5 of pneumonia after an illness of five days. Funeral services were held at the home Saturday afternoon, conducted by Rev. Joseph N. Haskell.

Mr. Langer was born in Norway March 13, 1865. When he was four years old his parents came to America and settled in Lake Crystal, Minn. In 1892 the family removed to Sanborn, which has been the home since.

Mr. Langer has been a man faithful in his home and among his friends and acquaintances; and was respected by all the community. The large number of friends at the services bears witness to the fact.

He was a member of the Congregational Church, in which he had a deep interest, bearing in his quiet life a love for his Master and faith in all His service among men. He was also a member of the Woodmen lodge, in which he carried an insurance of \$2000. The lodge attended the service in a body.

The deceased leaves a mother, Mrs. Maren Langer of Sanborn; two sisters, Mrs. C. F. Revell of Sanborn and Mrs. Dwight Simmons of Fargo; and three brothers, Mr. C. O. Langer of Sanborn, Mr. A. S. Langer of Dazey, and Mr. Emil Langer of Medina. The sympathy of the community is extended to the mother and family in their loss.

The body was carried to Lake Crystal, Minn., to be laid by the side of the father and brother.
