

OBITUARY.

Margaret Evans was born in Montgomeryshire, Wales, August 19, 1823, and died July 20, 1903, aged 79 years. She was married to Thomas Morton in the fall of 1849. Emigrated to America in 1851. Lived near Utica, N. Y., for three years, then removed to Joliet, Illinois, lived there until 1871, when they moved to the first home of their own, which was established in Ford county, Ill. In the spring of 1884 they moved to Minnie Lake, North Dakota. She was the mother of seven children. A husband and four children mourn their loss. When quite young she united with the Wesleyan Methodist church, in which faith she lived and died.

Her life was consistent and beautiful in its spirit of patience under much pain and trial and her end was peace. Funeral service was conducted by Rev. L. F. Powell, pastor of the Methodist Episcopal church of Tower City, North Dakota.
