

MRS. JATENS' FUNERAL.

The funeral of Mrs. M. E. Jaten occurred Sunday afternoon from the Norwegian M. E. church, Rev. Greene officiating. There was a large attendance of the friends of the deceased. Mrs. Jaten was born October 13, 1845, in Oftedal, Norway, her maiden name being Gurine Manson. In 1872 she came to Chicago, where she met and married M. E. Jaten. Four children were born to them there, Emily, Minnie, Charley and Martin. The summer of 1882 they moved to Valley City, making this their home ever since. Three more children were born to them here, Gilbert, Michael and Inga.

Her health was not good of late years, due to repeated attacks of gallstones, and on February 7 last she was taken very ill with blood poisoning, setting in her thumb and running up above the elbow. After the second week of her illness, her arm was doing well, but an attack of gallstones set in on the third week, which proved more than she could withstand.

She was a good wife and mother. Loved by all who knew her. Her love and tenderness for her husband and children will never be forgotten by them, and her last wish was that they should not grieve for her when gone, for she would meet them all in heaven.
