

DEATH OF CONRAD FOSS.

A telegram was received here Tuesday announcing the death of Conrad G. Foss, which occurred at Pomona, Cal., where Mr. Foss has been employed for the past year. His death was caused by consumption.

Mr. Foss was born in Norway and came to this country eleven years ago, when he was about 19 years of age. He came direct to Valley City and soon entered The Times-Record office, where he learned the printers' trade. For several years under Mr. Dunlap and later under the present management, he held the position of city editor, in which place he proved himself capable, energetic and successful. About three years ago his health commenced to fail and in the hope of finding a more suitable climate he made a trip to Colorado, where he remained but a short time. He afterwards made a trip to the old country and the rest and change apparently proved very beneficial. When he returned he found employment with Walker Bros. at Fargo, where he remained until he left for California. Mr. Foss was a member of the blue lodge, chapter and commandery at Valley City and of the shrine at Fargo. He had no relatives in this country except a brother, George Foss, who resides at Coopers-town.
