

## JOHN AMUNDSON DEAD.

John Amundson died at an early hour Tuesday morning, after a brief illness. Death was caused by heart failure. Mr. Amundson has had ill health for about a year, but has been able to attend to his business most of the time and was at work only a few days before his death, which came unexpectedly to his friends and acquaintances here in the city.

Mr. Amundson was born at Smedsberg, Norway, September 18, 1842, and came to America in 1866. In 1869 he was married to Miss Cecelia Ellison, at Centerville, Wis. He lived in St. Paul a few years and then moved to Hudson, Wis., where he remained until 1881, when he and his family moved to Barnes county, locating in Norman township. They lived there about five years and then removed to Valley City, where Mr. Amundson engaged in the plumbing business, also handling farm machinery. Mr. Amundson's wife died in 1898.

The funeral will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Lutheran Evangelical church and the services will be conducted by Rev. Beivik.
