

DEATH OF ROADMASTER JOHNSON.

Roadmaster J. E. Johnson, of the Sauborn branch of the N. P., died at his own home in Cooperstown at about 3 o'clock Monday afternoon, from a severe attack of pneumonia. A wife and family survive a faithful husband and a good father. The deceased had been in the employ of the Northern Pacific for many years and enjoyed the deepest confidence and highest esteem of his superiors. He was a member of the Masonic order in good standing, belonging to the Cooperstown lodge and to the chapter and commandery in Valley City. He was a member of the Cooperstown lodge, A. O. U. W., and carried a policy for \$2000. Whether he carried any other insurance is not at present known. The funeral was held from the home of the decedent, at Cooperstown, Wednesday afternoon.
