

# Beatha Eimon Dead

Miss Beatha Eimon, who made her home on the old Eimon ranch for many years is dead. She was one of the early settlers in Mabel township, leaving here about ten years ago when rheumatism compelled her to go to a hospital. The following is a newspaper clipping handed us by J. B. Howden: The funeral of Miss Beatha Eimon was held from the S. L. church conducted by Rev. E. B. Christophersen, Saturday, January 12. Miss Eimon was born May 7, 1856, in Norway and passed away at the Olson Hospital at Minneapolis January 8. She had been a sufferer from rheumatism and had spent several years at the above named hospital, although her last illness was pneumonia. She leaves four brothers to mourn her death, Christ, Peter and Ben at Superior, and Iver at Paso Robles, Calif.

Burial was at Osseo Wisconsin.
