

# Obituary

John Fadness was born Oct. 16, 1885, in Iowa. When small the family moved to Fosston Minnesota, and from there to Griggs county in 1907, where he spent the remainder of his life.

He was taken sick in 1912 with tuberculosis of the glands and had undergone 14 operations. The immediate cause of his death was cancer of the stomach which had confined him to his bed since December 15, 1924.

He died April 21, and was buried in the Glenfield cemetery the 23rd, the funeral being conducted in the Lutheran church of Glenfield by Rev. Thomas Haugen of McHenry,

Those left to mourn his death are his aged parents, three brothers, Gilbert, Sivert and Emil, all living nearby, and one sister, Mrs. Ed Chollett of Hinckley Minnesota; also an adopted sister, Mrs. Lowe of Sutton, and Adolph Berglund his nephew and adopted brother.
