As noted last week, Thomas Fallen, a former resident of this commmunity, passed way at his home in Sheboygan Falls Wisconsin, the principal cause of his death being inflammatory rheumatism. He had been ailing about a week from flu but was confined to his bed only three days. Below is a clipping from one of the papers of that city:

After a short illness, Thomas H. Fallen, aged 64, passed away at the family home in this city at 6:45 a.m. Saturday.

Mr. Fallen moved to this city two years ago, with his wife and family from Sutton, North Dakota, and leased the Arcade Pool Room, which he has been operating for a little more than a year.

He is survived by his wife, three sons, Edwin of Sheboygan Falls, Claude of Sutton, N. D. and William of Glasgow, Mont; three daughters, Mrs. Joseph Dahl of Van Hook, N. D., Mrs. Clarence Ebentier, of Sheboygan Palls and Florence Fallen of Sheboygan Falls.

Tuneral services were held Tuesday at 2:00 p. m. at the home, with the Rev. C. D. Mayhew officiating and hurial was made in the Falls cometery.

Mr Fallen was born in Boscobel, Wisconsin, Feb 26, 1866. At an early age he moved to Motley, Minnesota with his parents, where on March 26, 1894 he married Miss Ella May Perry. After residing in Minnesota for several years, the Falleus moved to Sutton, North Dakota, where they made their home 20 years before coming to the Falls.
