Again this community mourns the death of a good and noble woman, Mrs. C. O. Johnson, who died very suddenly Tuesday evening from heart trouble.

She moved in a limited sphere, but dispersed charity throughout the entire community. Her good deeds sprang from the love in heart and she carried on her noble work in a quiet, unostentatious manner. She was 68 years, 6 months and 29 days old at the time of her death and is survived by her husband and six children, three sons and three daughters: Frank M. Johnson of Bertha township Maynard S. Short funeral services were held here at the home on Friday morning at 8:30 after which she was taken to North Dakota for burial.
