

Obituary

Sylvia Josephine Larson was born on the place which has always been her home, near Sutton, November 9, 1906; died July 30, 1925, at the age of 18 years, 8 months and 21 days, after an illness of only four days, caused by intestinal influenza, together with a weak heart and kidney trouble.

She was baptized in the Mabel Lutheran church and was confirmed there also, April 27, 1919.

She attended high school at Sutton and Hannaford and graduated from the latter school with the class of 1924.

During the succeeding year she taught school near Medina and completed a very successful term there. Sylvia attended the state teachers' college at Valley City during the summers of 1924-5, and was so occupied until a week prior to her death.

Funeral services were held at the Mabel church Sunday, August 2.

She leaves to mourn her departure, her mother, Mrs. Severine Larson, two sisters, Thelma and Bertina, and two brothers, Leonard and Rasmus.

Thus, the second time in the short space of a few weeks the same community south of Sutton has been called upon to mourn the passing of a young life so full of hope and promise.
