

## Former Binford Girl Takes Her Own Life

Mrs. Florence Lewis, 39, night 'phone operator here who committed suicide Saturday, will be buried Tuesday at 2 p. m. after funeral services are conducted at the home of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Bove. Rev. A. A. Rumer, pastor of the Methodist church will officiate at the services and burial will be in the Finley cemetery. No inquest was held, death being clearly self-inflicted by drinking carbolic acid, E. E. Boe, Steel county cornor, declared tonight Mrs. Lewis, was found dead in her bed Saturday noon with an empty carbolic bottle near her. No reason for her death could be determined, although worry over financial affairs was given by several of her friends as the cause.

Mrs. Lewis, born in Coopers-town, married Lyman Lewis, from whom she later separated. In 1919 she moved to Fondulac Wisconsin and resided until three years ago when she came to reside with her parents here. She has been employed in the local telephone office for eight months.

Two children, Mrs. George Baldwin, Malta, Mont., and Adeline, 18, survive her. Mr. Lewis is now residing in Cooperstown.—Finley Cor. Binford Times.
