

Peter Lyle Dies

Sentinel Courier—Peter Lyle, Sr., aged 68 years, an old time resident of Griggs county, passed away at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Fred Councilman in Elmhurst Illinois, Tuesday, October 4th. Mr Lyle had made Elmhurst his home for the last eight years, moving there from this county where he had made his home in the Hannaford and Sutton vicinities. Mr. Lyle had been ill for more than a year, and had made his home with his daughter for over a year. Mr, and Mrs. Councilman moved to Elmhurst from Sutton about two years ago.

Mr. Lyle was born near Glasgow, Scotland, April 22, 1859. Thirty-five years ago he came to this country coming to Salt Lake City, Utah, where he lived for a number of years. Leaving Utah they moved to Griggs county, where the family lived for about twenty years

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Councilman and Mrs. Michael Smith, both of Elmhurst, and two sons, John Lyle of Joplin, Montana, and Peter Stuart Lyle of Elmhurst. One son, Robert Lyle was killed while a member of the A. E. F. being the first soldier from this county to be killed in action on July 15, 1918.

Funeral services were held the following Friday, and interment was made in the Elmhurst cemetery.
