

Alfred Olson Dead

Alfred Olson passed away at St. Luke's hospital in Fargo Monday morning, July 4 at one o'clock after suffering since October 1, 1926 with cancer. The body was brought to Sutton Tuesday, and at one o'clock Wednesday, funeral services were held from the home on the farm, Rev. Lunde of Cooperstown and Rev. Hanson of Litchville officiating.

Alfred Olson was born September 16, 1859 at Dahland, Sweden, and his age was 67 years and nine months. He came to Fargo in 1881 and to this neighborhood in 1885, where he was married to Emma Peterson in 1891. He is survived by the wife, Mrs. Emma Olson, and by Frank, Edith, Agda, Mabel, Arthur and Myrtle, the children. He is also survived by three brothers, Gustav of Chicago, Johnnie of Cole Harbor, and Chris of Sutton.

Those from a distance who attended the funeral were Hugo Forsberg from Carrington, John and Franc Olson from Cole Harbor, and J. S. Sortland and family from Litchville.

Mr Olson was a member of the Swedish Mission church to which with he adhered consistently. His was an upright character and he bore the respect and good will of all who knew him.
