Born in Westergotlande, Sweden, July 7, 1877; died at St. Luke's hospital, Fargo, November 31, 1927, his age being 50 years, four months and 24 days. He came to America in 1897 where he worked at his trade, that of brick mason and plasterer until a few years ago when he became afflicted with heart trouble. October 7 his condition became so serious that he was taken to Fargo:

Funeral services were held Thursday at the home of Mrs. Emma Olson, and conducted by Rev. G. O. Vikon, pastor of the Presbyterian church at Hannaford, assisted by Louis Peterson, singer, from Cooperstown. Interment was in Mabel cemetery.
