

B. F. Shaum Dead

The following account is taken from an Iowa newspaper:

"Frank Shaum, well known farmer who resides one mile west of Columbus Junction fell dead at 11:40 January 14 at the office of the Muscatine stock yards where he had gone to deliver stock.

Mr. Shaum was born about two miles west of Columbus Junction about 55 years ago and had always lived in this community except a few years spent in Chicago.

He married Miss Elizabeth Kinmonth who survives him. He is also survived by one son, Max, at home, and two brothers, Reuben Shaum at Ogden Utah and Joe in Kansas, and by one sister, Mrs. L. B. Hanna at Austin Minnesota.

The body was brought from Muscatine Friday afternoon and taken to the Richie funeral home at Columbus City."

Mr. Shaum was joint owner, with Mr. Kinmonth, of farms occupied by B. E. Hawkes, A. R. Boisjolie and Sivert Fadness, also the farm on which C. W. Smith formerly lived.
