Mr. Walker, the geologist who several months ago went over this section of the state in the quest for a suitable place to drill for oil was here again Monday, having returned from Kentucky to designate the exact spot on which to "spud in," The place is two miles west of Glenfield, on the north side of the state road, and back from the road about 300 feet.
