

Henry Gunderson, who has been drilling a well north of Red Willow Lake, was forced to discontinue work as reports from the state geologist showed there is no prospect of finding water except at a very great depth. The well was 240 feet in depth, 150 feet being in what is known as Pierre shale that is 1000 to 1400 feet deep, and in which no water has ever been found. Some years ago Mr. Gunderson drilled 900 feet in the same formation near Sharon without success.
