When the news reached Sutton Monday night from Hannaford that No. 2 had struck and killed a horse at the crossing near Frank Albrecht's there was much uneasiness for awhile as Lloyd Howden left for home on horseback shortly before the train arrived here, having been in for basket ball practise. After a search was made at the scene of the accident John Berg was called by phone and instructed to go to Lloyd's home and ascertain if he was there. He had returned safely, the horse he was riding having stumbled, throwing him off in time to escape being struck by the train himself.
