Killed in Action

Roy Lee Also Among Casualties Reported This Week

T. S. Davidson's received the sad news by wire Tuesday that their son John had been killed while in action in France, October 4. He went to Chicago last February and enlisted from there in the marines, landing across May 12. He was not of age but had wanted to enlist long before the consent of his parents was secured.

While the family is only one of the thousands that have been thus bereaved, their sorrow is none the less keen and the sympathy of the community is just as sincere. They have the consolation that he died fighting bravely for a great cause and that his name is on the nation's honor roll.

The casualty lists this week contained the name of Roy Lee of Pine River Minnesota, who was well known here, having worked a great deal for A. B. Sackett in his barber shop.
