

Obituary

John P. Larson was born March 19, 1864, and died March 23, 1919, at the age of 55 years and four days. He came from Norway when 16 years old, first stopping at Cooperstown. Later he settled on the farm not far from Sutton, where he lived the balance of his life.

He was married in 1903 to Mrs. Thu, who survives him, as well as three children, Leonard, Thelma and Sylvia, and two step-children, Rasmus and Bertina Thu

He had been sick for four years, the last two of which he was not able to talk. His extreme illness was during the last three weeks. He had to sit in a chair all of the time and two hours before he died was able to walk to the bed. He retained his senses to the very last and was able to communicate to the family by writing.
