

Ole Paulson Dead

Last week we chronicled the illness of Ole Paulson, and this week we must publish an account of his death which occurred at the hospital in Fargo Saturday evening at 8 o'clock. A week ago Sunday he was taken ill suddenly and for several hours was unconscious. When he rallied he complained of pains in his head and his mind was partly unbalanced. Later in the week he was taken to Fargo but he became rapidly worse and the folks were telephoned for. They went down Saturday evening but he was dead before they reached his bedside. A post-mortem examination was made which revealed the fact that there was a cancerous growth in his head, to which was attributed the cause of his death. The body was brought home Monday, and at one o'clock Thursday brief services in English were held at the church in Sutton. Following this the Norwegian funeral service was held at Mabel church, and interment was made in the cemetery there. An obituary will be published next week.
