

Obituary

Frank Starr, son of Robert Starr, was born in Mabel township, October 16, 1887; died February 7, 1920 age 32 years, 3 months and 21 days. He was one of a pair of twins, the other dying at six weeks of age. He was married March 17, 1909, to Miss Marie Bergman of Verdale, Minnesota, two children, Beatrice and Florence, being born to this union.
