Wimbledon was visited by a severe wind and hail storm Sunday afternoon, which did a great deal of damage to the crops. Two barns were blown down in that vicinity one north and one south of town. Hail stones as large as hens' eggs, are reported. The crowd that was at the ball game got the full benefit of the storm, the bail riddling automobile tops, smashing windshields etc. Charles Hochberger, who came up from Iowa last week, was badly hurt when a lemonade stand blew over and struck him as he was sitting in his son Fred's car. He could not be brought home, but is now at Wimbledon where he is being taken care of by a trained nurse.
