Shorty Russell was threshed Monday. However he doesn't feel any the worse for the experience. We mean he had his wheat threshed. He had about five acres seeded on his land and it averaged almost twenty bushels per acre, and No. 1 wheat at that. This land has not been seeded to small grain for several years, but has produced a crop or two of petatoes etc. and was well manured last year. The income from the ground will be equivalent to about fifteen acres of the ordinary wheat crop, which may indicate that a little rest and fertilizer might be a good thing to try out on some of our land.
