Saturday evening, Syver Simensen, a brother of Hans Simensen came here from Hannaford and visited at the latter's home until Tuesday. This was the first time the two had met in 27 years. In 1895 the former joined the rush to the Klondike in Alaska, and for 25 years was mourned as dead, no word having been received from him during that time. Two years ago he made a trip to Wisconsin, which was the first time the family here had learned anything about him since he went away. Although past 50 years of age the fure of gold mining is still in his veins and he with several of his western associates is planning a trip in the near future to the Siberian gold fields.
